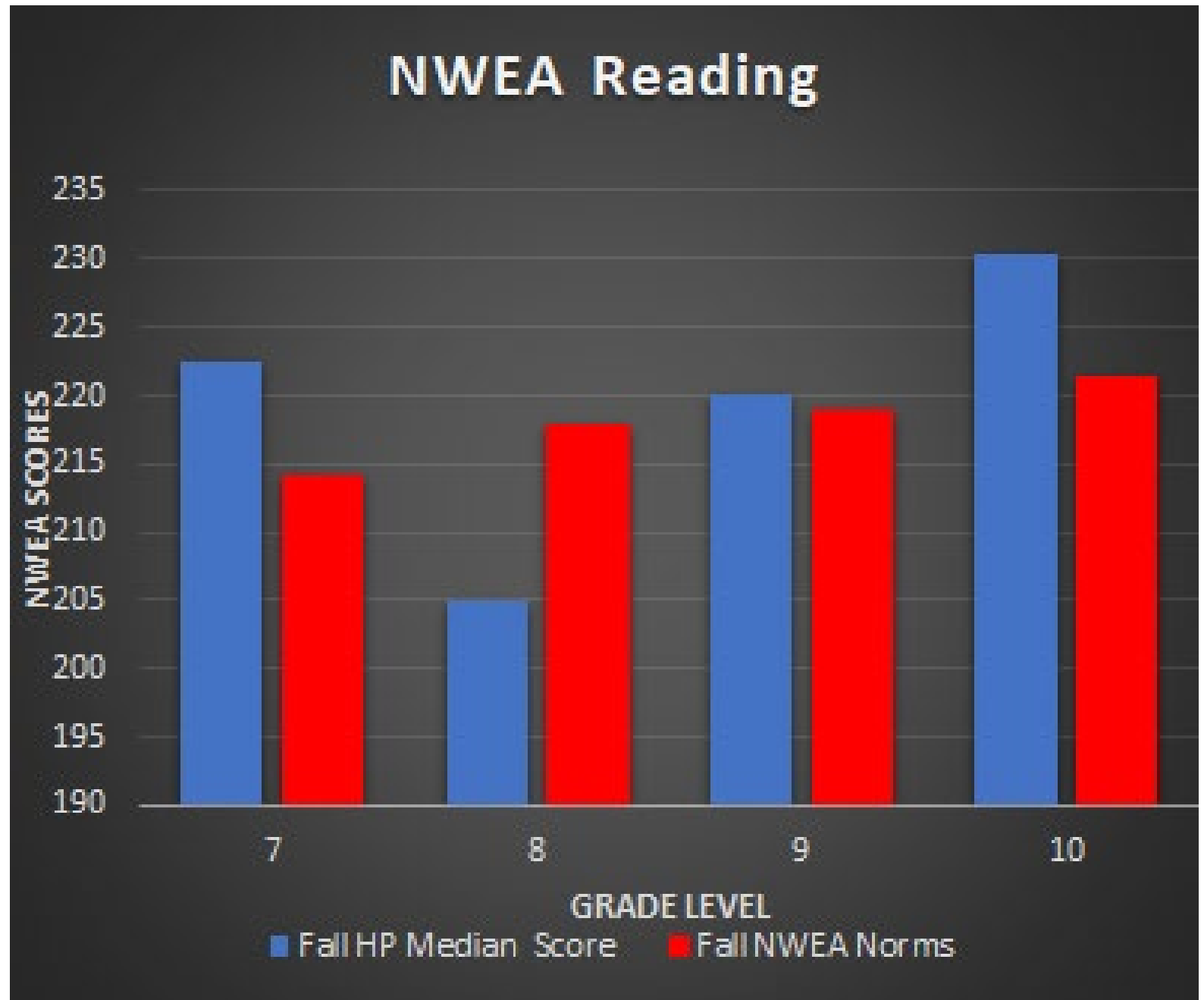

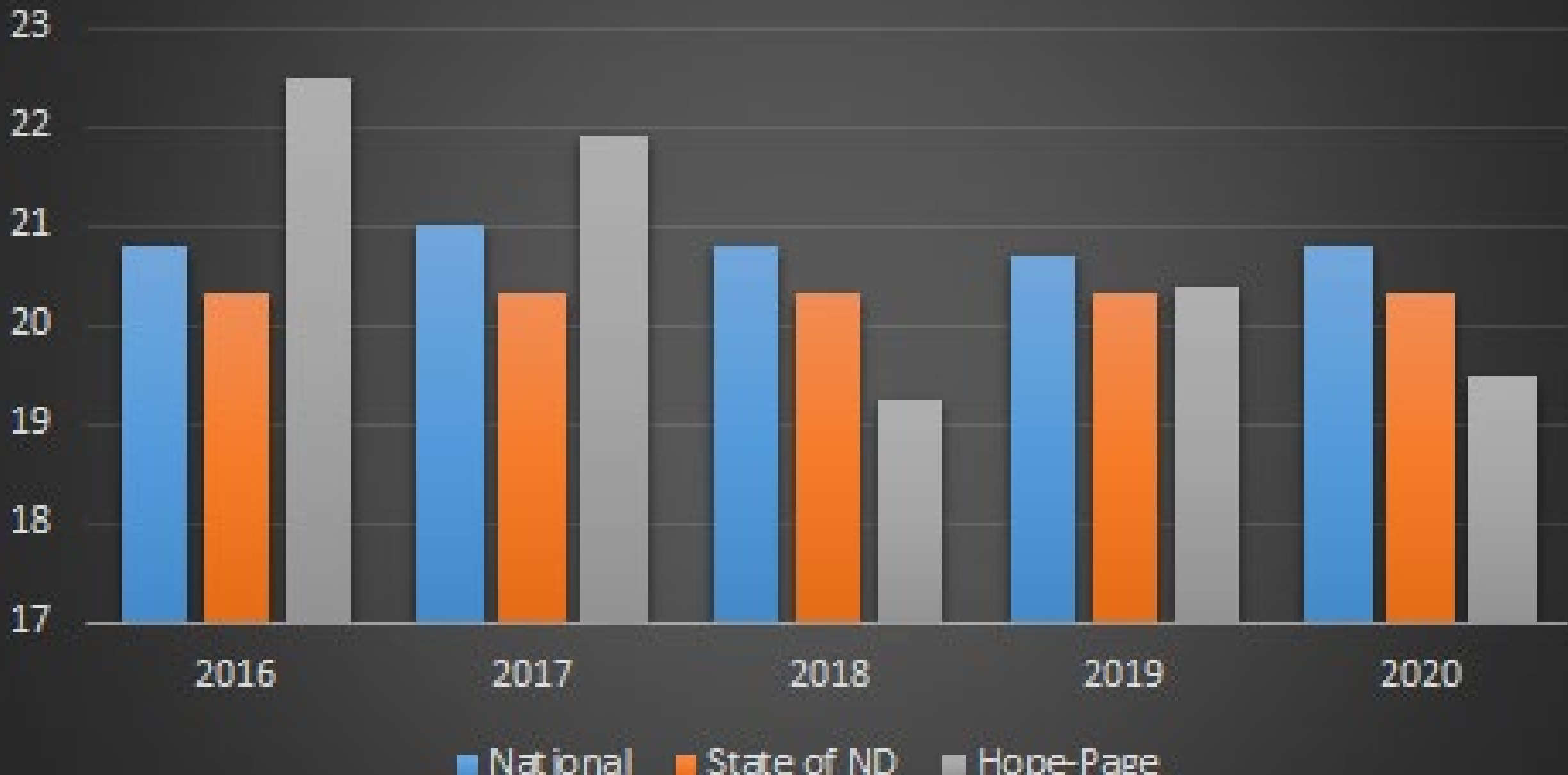

# ND Choice Ready Data

## Class of 2021

- Graduate Choice Ready: 100%
- Awarded the ND Scholarship: 60%
- College credits: 22, 24, & 26 credits

## Class of 2020

- Graduate Choice Ready: 86%
- Awarded the ND Scholarship: 86%
- College credits: 3(2), 6(1), 12(1), 15(3), 18(2) credits
- **\$117, 450+** awarded in scholarships

## Class of 2019

- Graduate Choice Ready: 70%
- Awarded the ND Scholarship: 50%
- College credits: 9(4) credits
- **\$54,950** awarded in scholarships

## Class of 2018

- Graduate Choice Ready: 75%
- Awarded the ND Scholarship: 63%

# Are our students prepared?

Elementary meets with jr. High teachers to determine what students are and are not prepared for.

K-12 teachers continue to look at data to determine if there are "gaps" where students are struggling as a whole. If those are identified staff will focus on those standards.
